The AFL OE Women's Advisory Group was formed in September 2020 and is represented by women from netball and football clubs in the league, the Umpires Association and Eastern Health - Health Promotion. The group's purpose is to raise the profile of women in the league, promote female inclusion and address matters affecting female football and netball club members and volunteers.

2021 objectives

- Develop a Gender Equality Policy.
- Advise the AFL Outer East commission on women & girls matters.
- Increase the capacity of clubs to include women.
- Promote respectful relationships in club culture and decision making through events and programs.

2 webinars were delivered in November 2020 with the aim to build capacity and encourage women to step into leadership positions. Women leaders from across the region shared their experiences to inspire others.
